Job Description:

Under general supervision, the successful Natural Gas Candidate in the Financial Analyst role will perform regulatory compliance work of considerable difficulty as a member of the Natural Gas Unit

in the application of Commission rules/policies, state/federal laws, finance/accounting principles and the

development of recommendations in matters concerning the regulation of Natural Gas Utilities, Municipal Gas Companies, and Natural Gas Marketers.

Duties and Responsibilities/Technical Skills:

The Natural Gas Candidate in the Financial Analyst role will work in the Commission's Natural Gas Unit and will conduct independent analyses on a wide range of financial matters. This will include the review financial statements, application of accounting principles, auditing, review capital budgets, applying trend analysis, variance analysis, review customer trends, market share, and the review of affiliate transaction data and methodologies. Additionally, the Natural Gas Candidate will work on, the regulated utility ratemaking process. The Natural Gas Candidate will develop a good working knowledge of the Georgia Statutes that governs the regulation of the state natural gas industry. This will include learning the natural gas marketer application process and the ongoing review of gas marketer financial and technical capability. The Natural Gas Candidate will use Excel to review and create financial models and conduct financial analysis. The Natural Gas

Candidate must apply critical thinking and analytical skills utilizing accounting/financial knowledge and/or natural gas regulatory practices and standards related to accounting, finance, and economics analyses. The Natural gas candidate must develop a good working knowledge of the natural gas industry and how this affects Georgia, including impacts from decisions made at the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC). The Natural Gas Candidate will be required to review projects, lead projects, make independent assessments, make recommendations, and write documents and reports. The Natural Gas Candidate will present recommendations before the Commission in a public forum with the ability to answer questions and defend positions.

Other Skills:

The Natural Gas candidate should demonstrate both leadership and team building skills, and be willing to establish and maintain collaborative working relationships with state government and industry officials. The Natural Gas Candidate must be able to multi-task and shift priorities as needed on assigned multiple projects. The Natural Gas Candidate must have a good command of verbal and written technical communications.

Minimum Qualifications:

Bachelor's degree in accounting or finance from an accredited college or university. Intermediate or above skills in Excel, Word, Outlook, and PowerPoint. Excellent oral, written, and presentation are essential skills.

Preferred Qualifications

3 to 5 years of regulatory experience in a comparable field. Graduate degree in accounting or finance.
